^{2.} Prior to the separation of the Issuer from Danaher Corporation ("Danaher") on July 2, 2016 (the "Separation"), one-fifth of the stock options issued by Danaher on July 25, 2012 ("2012 Danaher Options") to the Reporting Person became exercisable on each of the first five anniversary of the grant date.
